June 2nd, 2020 - in the late 19th and early 20th centuries stained glass artists in britain endeavoured to create ever more realistic images great pains were taken to create natural folds in the robes and the advent of photography and fine wood engraving encouraged artists to look again at light and shade'

June 5th, 2020 - the high middle ages 1001 1300 in the middle ages art was centered around the church the purpose of art was to glorify the life death and resurrection of jesus christ altshuler 2009 p 127 art was not made to produce a feeling it was made simply to tell a story artists were usually sanctioned by the church to plete specific works"william morris english artist designer arts and crafts

June 2nd, 2020 - morris himself was responsible for a few stained glass cartoon designs the foliage backgrounds to many figures drawn by the other artists and all matters to do with colouring he also designed wallpapers at first simple naturalistic ones such as daisy later from the early 1870s he designed papers such as jasmine full of depth and a suggestion of mysterious abundance'

May 28th, 2020 - the abbey of saint john at müstair switzerland is the site of exceptionally well preserved carolingian art the original church has several significant early medieval frescoes from around 800 ce the paintings are anized in five rows that stretch from the southern wall across the west wall to the northern wall"architecture timeline of important historic periods

June 4th, 2020 - churches and castles of the early medieval period were constructed with thick walls and heavy piers even as the roman empire faded roman ideas reached far across europe built

between 1070 and 1120 the basilica of st sernin in toulouse france is a good example of this transitional architecture with a byzantine domed apse and an added gothic like steeple 'the lindisfarne gospels smarthistory'

June 2nd, 2020 - introduction one of the most famous forms of medieval art irish illustrated manuscripts like the book of durrow c 650 680 and the book of kells c 800 were some of the first decorated christian gospel texts dating from the early seventh century ce in due course they were followed by medieval christian artworks such as carolingian and byzantine illuminated manuscripts'

'echternach gospels

April 14th, 2020 - function the echternach gospels were probably taken by willibrord to luxembourg when he founded the echternach monastery in the year 698 willibrord like many early medieval missionaries traveled throughout europe and used manuscripts to convert locals to christianity the echternach gospels are an example of many illuminated manuscripts that served as teaching tools as well as liturgical'
